Spotlight on Sixth Form life: What is the PPG programme?

"PPG stands for **Personal and Professional Growth**. We receive PPG mentoring and Head of Year post-18 one-to-one meetings which provide us with invaluable advice which guides us towards our future and ensures we have a clear plan for what we will be doing when we leave Ruislip High.

PPG mentoring with a specific staff mentor from the sixth form team allows us to discuss our future ambitions and explore our options through different university courses and apprenticeships. We are given advice on writing a successful application for competitive courses through supercurricular opportunities suggesting a deep interest and passion in our chosen course. This includes work experience, competitions, lectures and extra-reading in order to stand out ahead of other candidates.

In our Head of Year one-to-ones, we focus heavily on a unique selling point. This aspect of an application makes us unique and strongly boosts an application. We also receive regular emails and updates ensuring we stay up to date with opportunities and events so that we have the best chance of attending the university or apprenticeship of our choice.
