**Re: Year 11 Final Week and Prom Arrangements**

### Lockers

Students must make sure their lockers are emptied and clear of any rubbish by Friday 14th June 2024 (unless they have a Music exam on Monday 17th). Any items left in lockers after this date will be thrown away.

### Celebration Assembly and Shirt Signing - Friday 14th June

On Friday 14th June 2023, all students will sit a science exam in the afternoon. Following this exam, at around 3pm there will be the Celebration Assembly, followed by time for students to sign shirts and enjoy an ice cream in the sunshine with their teachers. Students will be leaving school at around 4pm and will need to go directly home. Any poor behaviour during this celebratory afternoon will result in students being unable to attend the Prom. A reminder that students need to be in full school uniform on this day, but should bring a spare shirt (and marker pens) for signing.

The date of your child's final exam is their last day of Year 11 and they should not return to school after this date, until we welcome the majority of students back on Monday 8th July for Sixth Form Induction Day.

### Year 11 Prom - Thursday 27th June 2024

The vast majority of students will be celebrating the end of Year 11 at the Prom on Thursday 27th June 2024, at Denham Grove Hotel, Tilehouse Lane, Denham, Uxbridge UB9 5DG. Students will be given their Prom ticket at the Celebration Assembly next week. Students and their families are welcome to take photographs outside the school before arriving at the venue. Students need to arrive at the hotel between 7.00-7.30pm and there will be another opportunity for photographs with family and friends here. A buffet will be served from 8pm, followed by a short awards ceremony and dancing until 11pm. Please note any dietary requirements for your child [here](#) by Friday 14th June. Students will need to bring a card if they wish to purchase any soft drinks throughout the evening. **All students must be picked up promptly at 11pm.** Any taxis need to be booked in advance as the hotel is fairly remote. We want students to have a really enjoyable evening; however, if students are found to be behaving inappropriately, vaping, smoking or having consumed any alcohol or drugs, they will be asked to leave the Prom immediately by security and parents/guardians will be contacted. Any behaviour of this nature will also put a student's place at sixth form at risk.
