

Core purpose

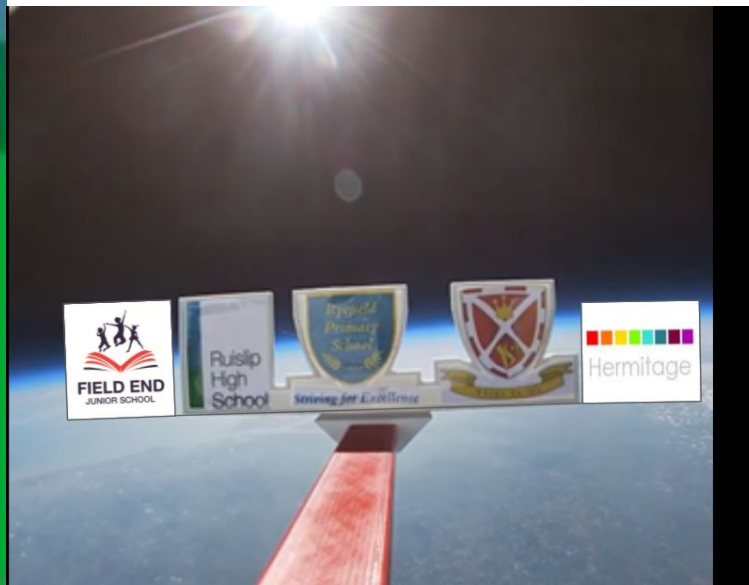

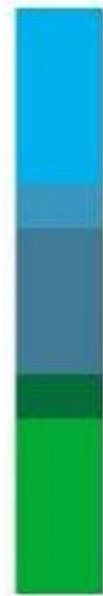
