Mr Mizen visited the school last academic year and spoke to various year groups about their son and the charity he has set up. On Friday 14 February 2025, b students in Year 7 will be invited to wear a jumper of their choosing to school to help support the "Jumpers for Jimmy" charity. They will still be expected to wear their school shirt, trousers or skirt. No blazer or tie will be required on that day.

To support the Jumpers for Jimmy, the cost is £1.00. This payment should be made via ParentPay in the usual way.

To ensure that the day runs smoothly and that there are no misunderstandings, here are the guidelines for the style of jumper and jeans which are acceptable:

Acceptable	Unacceptable
Jumper	Hoodies of any kind
Sweatshirt	Offensive logos or slogans
	Make up and/or jewellery

Students who wear hoodies to school will have them confiscated. If students do not wish to take part, they should wear their full school uniform including tie and blazer.
