I would like to start by thanking the staff and students who attended revision sessions during the half-term break. Students in Years 11 and 13 continue to be impressive during this busy examination period both in terms of their hard work in preparation for their examinations and their conduct. I would like to remind parents and guardians that students in Years 11 and 13 are expected in school for any compulsory revision sessions and their examinations. There are also revision areas available for students at all other times should students wish to revise in school. Year 10 students have their second Citizenship examination on Tuesday 14th June 2022; all Year 10 students should be in school by 8.50am as usual that day to attend revision sessions before the afternoon examination.

As part of the review, a number of students were spoken to and our reviewer was particularly impressed with how eloquently students could articulate what they have been learning and the clear level of pride students showed when they spoke about being Ruislip High School students.
