Dear Parents/Guardians

I would like to start by thanking parents/guardians for the support we have received following the government announcement on Wednesday regarding the wearing of face coverings in classrooms. I have contacted Public Health England this week due to the number of cases within the school and, given current transmission rates in our community, I have made the decision to continue with our current position that masks are to be worn inside the building whenever social distancing cannot be maintained. Should rates continue to fall in the school community, I anticipate removing this restriction in line with the government guidance. I will review this decision early next week and update parents/guardians prior to the next phase of relaxation of COVID measures due to come into force on Thursday 27th January 2022. I trust parents/guardians appreciate that this is not a simple decision and that my main priority has to be the health and safety of our community and reducing transmission rates to ensure that teachers can teach and students can attend school and learn.

Next week sees Year 13 undertake their pre-public examinations (PPEs) and I would like to thank students for the hard work they have put into preparing for these important assessments, and parents/guardians for supporting their child.
