Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: Year 11 Parents'/Guardians' Evening - Thursday 23rd January 2025

We would like to invite you to the Year 11 Parents'/Guardians' Evening on Thursday 23rd January 2025. This is a really important opportunity for you and your child to receive feedback from subject teachers following their PPE's (pre-public examinations), which have taken place over the past two weeks.

During the evening, your child will receive an envelope containing their PPE grades (referring to the examined component(s) for each subject) and teacher predicted grades (TPGs), based on teachers' professional judgement, taking into account PPE grades and other relevant information. I appreciate that, for some students, this may be an anxious time, and we believe that part of the PPE process is to allow students to have the experience of opening an envelope in a similar way to how they will receive the results in August. There will be members of the pastoral team available should your child require further support. We occasionally get requests during the course of Year 11 for students to reduce the number of subjects they take as we move towards the summer examinations. I would like to reassure you that your child will be fully supported both in lessons and outside of lessons, and that experience shows us that reducing subjects is highly unlikely to be a solution at this stage.

Appointments with each subject teacher can be made using our online booking system, which will open today, enabling you to book your preferred time slots with staff directly. Appointment times will be limited to five minutes and made on a first-come, first-served basis. Appointments will be held in person from 4:30pm to 7:00pm and students are expected to join their parents/guardian during the appointment and wear their full school uniform. Please note that appointments will not take place for Cultural Studies or core PE classes.

By using the link below you will also be able to confirm your attendance at the evening. Please confirm your attendance by Friday 10th January 2025. Please note that, if attendance is not confirmed, you will receive a phone call from a member of the Year 11 team; this is a supportive measure to see if we can help and make any arrangements necessary for your attendance on the evening.
